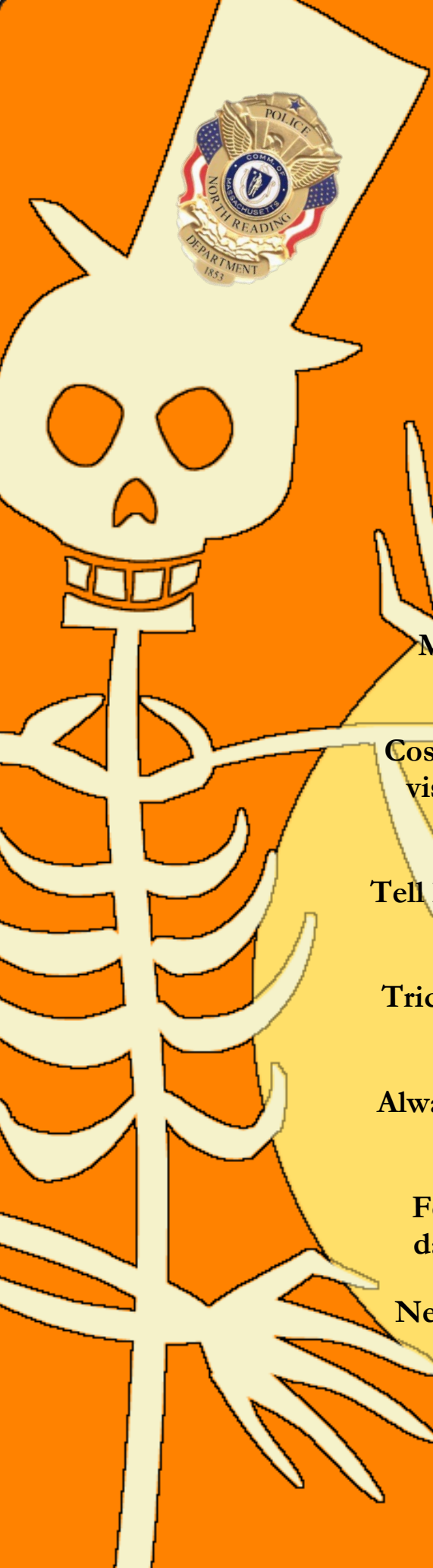




North Reading Police Halloween Safety Tips

Think Safety!

Make up is better than masks, as masks can obstruct a child's vision.

Costumes should be nonflammable and allow for visibility, adding reflective tape or glow sticks makes little monsters easier to see.
